STANDING REFERRAL ORDER
RE: CRIMINAL ACTIONS ASSIGNED TO
JUDGE RICHARD A. SCHELL

In accordance with the Local Rules of Court for the Assignment of Duties to United States Magistrate Judges, it is ORDERED:

1. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(A), all pretrial motions in Sherman Division criminal cases assigned to United States District Judge Richard A. Schell, with the exception of motions to suppress evidence, to dismiss or quash an indictment or information made by the defendant, to continue, and to sever, are hereby REFERRED to United States Magistrate Judge Don D. Bush for consideration and hearing as deemed necessary, and a determination.
2. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and (C), all pleas of guilty in Sherman Division criminal cases assigned to United States District Judge Richard A. Schell shall be REFERRED to United States Magistrate Judge Don D. Bush for the Fed. R. Crim. P. 11 guilty plea allocution subject to Defendant's consent and subject to the control, final approval, and imposition of sentence by the District Judge.

After the administration of a guilty plea allocution pursuant to this Order, the United States Magistrate Judge shall file appropriate proposed findings of fact and recommendations.
