GENERAL ORDER APPOINTING U.S. MAGISTRATE JUDGE CHARLES EVERINGHAM
IV

In September 2006 the Judicial Conference of the United States authorized the creation of a new full-time magistrate judge position with a duty station of Marshall, Texas. Thereafter, the district judges of this court appointed a Merit Selection Panel to nominate individuals whose character, experience and ability fully qualified them for the position of magistrate judge. The Merit Selection Panel, in its report and recommendation to the court, designated five applicants whom it deemed most qualified to serve in this position. The judges of this court have concurred in the appointment of one of the five designated individuals, namely, Charles Everingham IV.

The Court hereby appoints Charles Everingham IV to the position of United States Magistrate Judge for the Eastern District of Texas, effective April 1, 2007, with his duty station being designated as Marshall, Texas.
