

GENERAL ORDER REGARDING THE FILING OF PARIS DIVISION CASES

In order to efficiently manage the Paris Division caseload in accordance with the new assignment of cases under General Order 97-2, all pleadings, motions, responses, orders, judgments, and other filings in Paris Division civil and criminal cases should be filed with the district clerk's office in Beaumont. In an emergency, attorneys may file Paris pleadings in another division, e.g., Tyler or Sherman. The Clerk shall forward such pleadings to the Beaumont Division for filing, and shall maintain the original Paris case files in the Beaumont Division.
