ORDER AMENDING THE PLAN FOR RANDOM SELECTION OF JURORS

It is hereby ORDERED that the Plan for Random Selection of Jurors for the Eastern District of Texas, be and the same is hereby amended, subject to approval by a reviewing panel of members of the Fifth Judicial Circuit Council:

This court is a participant in the Judicial Conference's experimental use of a one-step summoning and qualification procedure, as authorized by section 805 of Pub. L. No. 100-702, 28 U.S.C. § 1878. Accordingly, upon the commencement of this experiment and for the duration thereof, jurors shall be qualified and summoned in a single procedure, in lieu of the two separate procedures otherwise provided for by the Jury Selection and Service Act and this plan. The emptying (removal) of unused names in the qualified wheels shall be delayed to September 1 during this experiment.
