Whereas, the General Services Administration has authorized the closing on December 26, 1986, of each of the Federal Buildings in the Eastern District of Texas in which the division offices of the U. S. District Clerk's Office are maintained, thereby making it impossible for these offices to remain open on December 26, 1986; and

Whereas, in accordance with Rule 77(c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, it is required that the Clerk's Offices, with a Clerk or a Deputy in attendance, shall be open during business hours on all days except Saturday, Sunday, and Legal Holidays; now, therefore,

It is ORDERED, that on Monday, December 29, 1986, upon the written certification of any attorney at law or any pro se litigant, that the closing of the Federal Buldings on December 26, 1986, prevented his filing any pleading or other proper paper, the Clerk of the Court is authorized to file such pleading or other proper paper, and to place upon it the file date of December 26, 1986.
