GENERAL ORDER

86-5: Assignment of Habeas Corpus Applications

Acting by the consent of the judges of this Court, it is **ORDERED** that all applications for the writ of habeas corpus heretofore filed by inmates of the Texas Department of Corrections against any officer, agent, or employee thereof in the Eastern District of Texas pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2254 shall be, and they are hereby, assigned to the Honorable Robert M. Parker, United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Texas, with the exception of the following applications, which shall be retained by the judge to whom they are presently assigned:

Livingston v. Estelle, Civil Action No. S-77-75-CA

White v. Estelle, Civil Action No. S-77-55-CA

Woodkins v. Estelle, Civil Action No. S-77-128-CA

Corley v. Estelle, Civil Action No. TY-80-2-CA

Vanderbilt v. Estelle, Civil Action No. B-82-912-CA

It is further


**ORDERED** that all applications for the writ of habeas corpus hereafter filed by inmates or former inmates of the Texas Department of Corrections against any officer, agent, or employee

thereof pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2254 shall be, and they are hereby, assigned to Judge Parker. It is further

**ORDERED** that the files relating to such habeas corpus applications shall be maintained in the divisions where they have been filed, or will be filed, respectively, until the further order of Judge Parker. It is further

**ORDERED** that the Clerk for the Eastern District of Texas shall provide copies of this order to all applicants for the writ of habeas corpus whose applications are reassigned accordant to this order.
