
ORDER VACATING MISCELLANEOUS ORDER NO. 07-1

General Order 07-3 establishes divisional assignments and apportionment of cases among magistrate judges. Section III, B. of that order provides a mechanism for transfers between magistrate judges to equalize dockets or for other appropriate reasons. On May 17, 2007, the undersigned issued a Transfer Order, ordering that all pending and future habeas corpus cases filed in this division under 28 U.S.C. §§ 2241, 2254, and 2255 that would be referred to the undersigned under General Order 07-3 be transferred to Hon. Earl S. Hines and Hon. Keith Giblin, randomly and equally. Judges Hines and Giblin concurred with the May 17, 2007 Transfer Order.

The undersigned hereby **VACATES** the May 17, 2007 Transfer Order. As of this date, all pending and future habeas corpus cases filed in this division under 28 U.S.C. §§ 2241, 2254, and 2255 that would be referred to the undersigned under General Order 07-3 shall be referred to the Honorable Caroline M. Craven for pretrial purposes.
