


IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE UNITED STATES

GENERAL ORDER AS TO CIVIL ACTIONS
FILED IN ALL DIVISIONS IN THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF TEXAS

WHEREAS: A majority of the United States District Judges for the Eastern District of Texas have agreed that effective immediately in cases where a filing of a civil action has been made and docketed by the Clerk and assigned to a specific judge, and thereafter the party filing said civil action elects to take a non-suit or voluntary dismissal, and subsequently refiles the same cause of action, in such case the civil action will be assigned to the particular United States District Judge to whom it was originally assigned.

It is accordingly ORDERED that as to all future filings of civil actions in the Eastern District of Texas, the case will be assigned to the particular District Judge to whom it was originally assigned in those cases where the plaintiff elects to take a non-suit or voluntary dismissal.


