GENERAL ORDER GOVERNING  
INTRA-DISTRICT TRANSFERS

It is ORDERED that:

1. When a judge of this Court orders the transfer of a civil or criminal action to a division where he regularly sits pursuant to the General Orders of this Court, the Clerk shall assign the action to such judge.
2. When a judge of this Court orders an intra-district transfer of a civil or criminal action to a division where he does not regularly sit pursuant to the General Orders of this Court, the Clerk shall assign such action to a judge regularly sitting there, following the procedure now prescribed for the random assignment of newly filed actions. Provided, however, that if the judge ordering the transfer stipulates in the order that he retains the action upon his docket, the Clerk shall assign it to such judge.
