GENERAL ORDER

Pursuant to the Bail Bond Reform Act, the United States Probation Office, Eastern District of Texas, is hereby designated as the agency responsible for the supervision and investigation of defendants released on bond or other conditions of release by either a United States District Judge or a United States Magistrate, when such supervision is made a part of the Conditions of Release. The Chief Probation Officer shall administer such program and set forth such rules and procedures as may be necessary for the implementation and agency operation.

The standard "Special Conditions of Release" for defendants under supervision of the United States Probation Office shall be as follows:

- (1) You shall keep the U. S. Probation Office advised of your residence, and you shall not change residence without first notifying the U. S. Probation Office;
- (2) You shall report to the U. S. Probation Office at such reasonable times and places as you may be directed;
- (3) You shall notify the U. S. Probation Office immediately if you are arrested or questioned by law enforcement officers;

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF RELEASE ON BOND

The Court has released you on bond pending trial and disposition of your case. In addition to the regular Conditions of Release, the Court has ordered that you be supervised by the U. S. Probation Office under the following terms and conditions:

- (1) You shall keep the Probation Office advised of your residence, and you shall not change residence without first notifying the Probation Office;
- (2) You shall report to the Probation Office at such reasonable times and places as you may be directed;
- (3) You shall notify the Probation Office immediately if you are arrested or questioned by law enforcement officers;
- (4) [Specify any other condition of release.]

Your signature below acknowledges that you have read (or have had read to you) this document; that you understand same; and that you will abide by the terms and conditions herein. Failure to abide by these terms and conditions will result in a report to the Court and subject you to possible forfeiture of your bond, if any, and subsequent incarceration.
