ORDER SETTING COMPENSATION
OF SUBSTITUTE SPECIAL MASTER
BIG THICKET NATIONAL PRESERVE

The Court, by order entered on September 10, 1982 appointed the Honorable Jack B. Osborne to serve as Substitute Special Master in the matter of the acquisition of certain lands situated within the Big Thicket National Preserve. It is therefore

ORDERED, pursuant to the authority set forth in Rule 53(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, that the rate of compensation to be paid to said Special Master shall be Three Hundred Dollars and no/cents (\$300.00) per day. The reimbursement for travel and subsistence for the Special Master shall be as set by the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts for employees of the Court. Said compensation and the expenses of the Special Master are hereby taxed as costs and shall be paid by the United States of America.

It is further ORDERED that the compensation for the Substitute Special Master and the reimbursement for his travel and subsistence shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
