It appearing that the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts has voted to continue the magistrate's position for an additional eight-year term of office; and


The judges of this court, desiring to consider the reappointment of incumbent magistrate, Earl S. Hines, accordingly, did appoint a Merit Selection Panel to assist the judges in their determination as to the reappointment of the incumbent; and

It appearing that the Panel did review the incumbent's performance in office as a magistrate and did unanimously recommend the incumbent for reappointment;

NOW THEREFORE, the judges of this court, after due consideration of the report of the Panel, unanimously concur in the reappointment of Earl S. Hines to a new term in the position of United States magistrate for the Eastern District of Texas, effective March 7, 1992, with his duty station being designated as Beaumont, Texas.
