TITLE 36, CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS, PART 9, SUBPART B (NON-FEDERAL OIL AND GAS RIGHTS)

Part 9.32 ACCESS

The following are prohibited:

- (a) (b) Unauthorized access on, across, \$500.00 or through lands or waters to a site for operations.
- (c) Unauthorized use of any kind of \$100.00 any kind of aircraft for access to a site for operations without an approved Plan of Operations.
- (d) Unauthorized access across the \$250.00 unit to a site outside the unit a without an approved permit except by designated road or trail.
- (e) Unauthorized directional drilling MA into any unit from an area outside the boundaries without an approved Plan of Operations.

Part 9.33 EXISTING OPERATIONS

The following is prohibited:

(a) Continuing to conduct operations MA after January 8, 1979 with an expired Federal or State permit and without an approved Plan of Operations.

Part 9.34 TRANSFERS OF INTEREST

The following is prohibited:

(a) Failure to notify the \$500.00 Superintendent within 60 days of the transfer of site(s) involved; the name and address of the person to whom the interest in conveyed, and a description of the interest transferred.

- (a) (2) (vii) Failure to reestablish native \$500.00 vegetative communities.
- (b) Failure to provide for the \$500.00 safe movement of native wildlife...and the return of the area to a condition which does not jeopardize visitor safety or public use.

Part 9.40 SUPPLEMENTATION OR REVISION OF PLANS OF OPERATION

The following is prohibited:

(b) Failure to submit a revised \$250.00 Plan of Operation 60 days prior to the date changes become effective in the original approved plan.

Part 9.41 OPERATING STANDARDS

The following is prohibited:

(a)	Conducting surface operations within 500 feet of waterways or within 500	\$500.00
	of waterways or within 500 feet of any structure.	

(b) Destruction of survey \$250.00 monuments and boundary markers.

- (c) Failure to close well-head \$250.00 valves or blowout prevention equipment when producing operations are suspended for 24 hours or more, but less than 30 days. Failure to install a suitable plug or other fittings when operations are suspended for 30 days or more.
- (d) Failure to mark each \$100.00 operating derrick in a conspicuous place with the operator's name or the name of the owner, and the number and location of the well.
- (e) Failure to erect a fence \$500.00 acceptable to the Superintendent around existing wells, storage tanks and high pressure facilities.
- (f) Failure to remove \$500.00 accumulations of oil or other materials deemed to be fire hazards; failure to remove from the property or store in an ordinary manner all scrap and other materials not in use; failure to maintain the site in a safe and workmanlike manner for the preservation of the environment.

Part 9.42 WELL RECORDS AND REPORTS, PLOTS AND MAPS, SAMPLES, TESTS AND SURVEYS

The following is prohibited:

(a) Failure to provide to the \$100.00 Superintendent upon his request any technical data during the drilling of any well, including daily drilling reports and geological reports.

Part 9.43 PRECAUTIONS NECESSARY IN AREAS WHERE HIGH PRESSURES ARE LIKELY TO EXIST

The following is prohibited:

(a) Failure to install and \$500.00 maintain high-pressure fittings and equipment in areas where high pressures exist.

Part 9.44 OPEN FLOWS AND CONTROL OF WILD WELLS

The following is prohibited:

(a) Failure to take all MA feasible precautions to prevent any oil or gas well from blowing open and taking immediate steps to bring under control and "wild well", or burning oil or gas well.

Part 9.45 HANDLING OF WASTES

The following is prohibited

(a) Failure to confine oil field \$500.00 brine and all other waste and contaminating substances so as to prevent escape and contamination, pollution, damage to the lands, waters, facilities, cultural, resources, wildlife and vegetation of or visitors to the unit.

Part 9.46 ACCIDENTS AND FIRES

The following is prohibited:

(a) Failure to take all feasible MA precautions to prevent accidents and fires; failure to notify the Superintendent within 24 hours of all accidents involving serious personal injury or death or fires on the site; failure to submit a written report to the Superintendent within 90 days.

Part 9.47 CULTURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

The following is prohibited:

- (a) Injuring, altering, destroying MA or collecting any object of historical, archeological or cultural scientific importance in violation of the Antiquities Act.
- (b) Failure to bring to the MA attention of the Superintendent any cultural scientific resource encountered that may be altered or destroyed by operations.

Part 9.48 PERFORMANCE BONDS

The following are prohibited:

- (a) Failure to file a \$250.00 performance bond upon approval of a plan of Operations.
- (b) Failure to deposit cash or \$250.00 negotiable bonds (in lieu of a performance bond) upon approval of a Plan of Operations.

Part 9.51 DAMAGES AND PENALTIES

The following are prohibited:

(a) Failure to comply with an MA approved plan of Operations or permit, or, where operations are temporarily approved under 9.38, failure to comply with the terms of that approval.
