## REFERRAL ORDER RE: CRIMINAL ACTIONS ASSIGNED TO JUDGE RICHARD A. SCHELL

In accordance with the Local Rules of Court for the Assignment of Duties to United States Magistrate Judges, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A), all pretrial motions in Sherman Division criminal cases assigned to United States District Judge Richard A. Schell and heard in Plano, Texas, with the exception of motions to suppress evidence, to dismiss or quash an indictment or information made by the defendant, to continue, to sever, and to transfer venue, are hereby **REFERRED** to United States Magistrate Judge Don D. Bush for consideration and hearing as deemed necessary, and a determination.
- 2. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A), all pretrial motions in Sherman Division criminal cases assigned to United States District Judge Richard A. Schell and heard in Sherman, Texas, with the exception of motions to suppress evidence, to dismiss or quash an indictment or information made by the defendant, to continue, to sever, and to transfer venue, are hereby **REFERRED** to United States Magistrate Judge Amos L. Mazzant for consideration and hearing as deemed necessary, and a determination.
- 3. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and (C), all pleas of guilty in Sherman Division criminal cases assigned to United States District Judge Richard A. Schell and heard in Plano, Texas shall be **REFERRED** to United States Magistrate Judge Don D. Bush for the FED. R. CRIM. P. 11

guilty plea allocution subject to defendant's consent and subject to the control, final approval, and imposition of sentence by the District Judge.

4. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and (C), all pleas of guilty in Sherman Division criminal cases assigned to United States District Judge Richard A. Schell and heard in Sherman, Texas shall be **REFERRED** to United States Magistrate Judge Amos L. Mazzant for the FED. R. CRIM. P. 11 guilty plea allocution subject to defendant's consent and subject to the control, final approval, and imposition of sentence by the District Judge.

After the administration of a guilty plea allocution pursuant to this Order, the United States Magistrate Judge shall file appropriate proposed findings of fact and recommendations.
