GENERAL ORDER ASSIGNING CIVIL AND CRIMINAL ACTIONS

In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 137 and the agreement of the judges affected hereby, it is **ORDERED** that all civil and criminal cases filed shall be randomly assigned to individual judges of this district in the proportions noted below, with the exception of bankruptcy appeal cases and death penalty habeas corpus cases, which shall be randomly assigned among the active district judges from the associated district-wide decks, with the following exceptions: a death penalty habeas corpus case brought by a petitioner who was convicted in this district or who raises a challenge that is successive to one previously filed in this district shall be assigned to the judge who handled the prior case, if the judge is currently active.

This General Order supersedes all prior General Orders assigning civil and criminal actions.


