GENERAL ORDER AUTHORIZING EXTENDED SERVICE JUROR FEES

Under 28 U.S.C. § 1871(b), a petit juror who is required to attend more than ten days in hearing one case may be paid an additional \$10 attendance fee for each day in excess of ten days on which the juror is required to hear such case. Likewise, a grand juror required to attend more than forty-five days of actual service may be paid an additional \$10 attendance fee for each day in excess of forty-five days of actual service.

With approval of the Court, it is ORDERED that the additional daily attendance fee be applied automatically to the usual attendance fee for petit and grand jurors when they reach the statutory minimum for this additional fee without further direction from the presiding judge. A presiding judge may direct in any case that the additional fee not be paid by notifying the Clerk of Court.
